



## GO Kickball Winter 2011-12 Tournament Format

- 1) After the 7-week regular season is complete, every team participates in the first round of the season-ending tournament. The tournament is played the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> weeks of the season.
- 2) The first round of the playoffs will take place on the week after the regular season is complete (8<sup>th</sup> week) and each team will play on their normal day and timeframe. Tentative dates for each league tournament are:
  - Saturday Piedmont league: Feb 11<sup>th</sup>
  - Sunday Piedmont league: Feb 12<sup>th</sup>
  - Wednesday Peachtree Hills league: Feb 15<sup>th</sup>
  - Tuesday Hammond Park league: Feb 7<sup>th</sup>
- 3) League tournament opponents and game times are determined after the regular season is complete, and will be announced via email and on the website the day after each league's 7<sup>th</sup> week games.
- 4) All teams in each division at the end of the regular season play a single-elimination tournament starting the 8<sup>th</sup> week and winners advance to the **Atlanta City Tournament on Saturday, February 18<sup>th</sup> at Coan Middle School** in Little Five Points. (9<sup>th</sup> week) (The rainout dates are Sun, Feb 19<sup>th</sup> or Sun, Feb 26<sup>th</sup> ).
- 5) League/Division standings are determined as follows:
  - a. Overall Win-Loss Record
  - b. If tie, then Division Win-Loss Record
  - c. If tie, then Head-to-Head meetings (only if one of the teams in the tie has beaten the other(s) tied with them in the standings)
  - d. If tie, then Overall Power Rating
  - e. If tie, then Division Power Rating.

NOTE: Power Rating is defined in the Ranking Formula explanation, which can be accessed from the GOkickball.com website on the Schedules/Standings page for each league (above the Overall Standings).

- 6) Atlanta City Tournament Championship (9<sup>th</sup> week) games:
  - a. All games are **played Saturday, February 18th at Coan MS** in Little Five Points. (The rainout dates are Sun, Feb 29<sup>th</sup> or Sun Feb 26th)
  - b. All winners of each league's playoff games (from week 8) advance to the tournament championship. The Winter 2011-12 Tournament Championship will include 20 teams.
  - c. Each league's playoff game winners from week 8 will meet first during the tournament championship to determine their respective league champion.
  - d. Once each league has a champion, all those champions continue and play against other league champions to ultimately determine the *GO Kickball Winter 2011-12 Atlanta City Champion*.
