What is Cornhole?

It has been called many things but to many of us born and raised in Kentucky and the southern part of Ohio, the game is passionately referred to as Cornhole for last 100 years.

Cornhole is similar to horseshoes except you use wooden boxes and corn bags instead of horseshoes and metal stakes. Contestants take turns pitching their corn bags at the boxes until a contestant reaches the score of 21 points. A bag in the hole scores 3 points, while one on the box scores 1 point.

Scoring cancels out can be swift and the lead may change hands several times in a match before the winner is decided. If you can aim and toss a corn bag 30 feet, you can master the game of Cornhole

The biggest reason to play Cornhole instead of horseshoes or other similar games is that Cornhole can be played anywhere and everyone can play Cornhole.
